

HOW TO TRAVEL TO LAMPETER


By car

From the south-east, at junction 49 of the M4, take the A48 to Carmarthen and the A485 north to Lampeter. From the south-west take the A40 to Carmarthen and then the A485 north to Lampeter. From North Wales take the A470 south to Dolgellau, the A487 to Aberaeron and then the A482 to Lampeter. For alternate routes see diagram below.

By Coach or Train

The nearest railway stations are at Carmarthen and Aberystwyth, with connections by bus to Lampeter. For details of bus links or for coach travel, please ring the Traveline on 0871 200 2233 or check out the web page at: <http://www.trawscymru.info/>

The Campus is on College Street (A485) in the centre of the town.

LAMPETER PHOTOGRAPHIC CONVENTION

Saturday 3rd September and Sunday 4th September 2015

The annual WPF Photographic Convention is held at the Lampeter Campus of the University of Wales Trinity St David on either the last weekend in August or the first weekend in September, depending on the eccentricities of the calendar.

And what better way could we spend this weekend than by being entertained and educated by some of the most able and experienced photographers in the country. They are all experts in their particular field of photography and can give us new ideas to expand our own photography and maybe to explore aspects we have been hesitant to experiment with previously.

As in the past, the Convention will be held in the Cliff Tucker Theatre and we have the use of the adjacent rooms for both trade stands and to display the prints entered for the competition.

Accommodation is in Lloyd Thomas Hall in single en-suite rooms. Meals are in the dining room to the rear of the hall, with self-service breakfast and lunch on both days and a three-course, waitress service dinner on Saturday evening. Tea, coffee and biscuits will be served at intervals on both days.

While most delegates arrive at the College on Saturday morning, many choose to arrive on Friday. In this case, the cost for bed and breakfast for Friday must be added to the cost of the weekend. Please refer to the booking form for details of these.

In addition:

Trade Stands: There will be one or two photographic companies with us on the Saturday.

Print Competition: Each delegate can bring along ONE print to be entered in the competition. The prints will be put on display on Saturday and judged at the end of the day.

Prize Raffle: There will also be a raffle which will be drawn in the afternoon on Sunday.

Essential information

On arrival


Keys to the rooms must be collected from Reception (17) in the St David's building (3) which is situated to the right when driving through the main gate.

On entering the building the office is on the right at the top of a short flight of steps. There are parking facilities on campus; please ask a member of staff on duty at the reception desk for directions.

Lloyd Thomas Hall (32) is directly ahead on entering through the main gate. The Dining Room (43) is behind the hall and reached by going down the flight of steps to the right of the Hall. The Cliff Tucker Lecture Theatre (2) is adjacent to the river and tennis courts.

For delegates arriving on Friday 28th August, there are no meals available in the college on Friday evening. However, there are a number of pubs that serve food and restaurants in the town of Lampeter.

Wendy Conway is an International Award Winning Wildlife Photographer. She loves travel, especially overseas (the more exotic the better) and being immersed behind the camera. After a lifetime in industry Terry re-invented himself and since then, accompanied by Wendy, he has been working full time as a Wildlife Photographer. In 2010 he gained the prestigious Platinum Distinction awarded by La Federation International de l'Art Photographique, only the twelfth photographer in the UK to gain such a distinction in 25 years. In December 2015 he gained the coveted PAGB MASTER Distinction.

Terry and Wendy travel widely, favourite destinations being the USA and Kenya only surpassed by a journey to the end of the world: Japan. Recent trips saw them photographing in the stunning countryside of Bulgaria followed by Hungary. 2015 surpassed all previous European journeys with a visit to Spain for the marvellous Bonelli's Eagle.

The guest speakers at the Convention this year are :-

Adrian Lines MPAGB FBPE EFIAP ARPS

Adrian first became interested in photography after buying a Bridge camera whilst on a family trip to London. He quickly moved on to his first DSLR and joined a local Photographic Society (Wigan PS) in an attempt to become more proficient with the equipment. After twelve months he started to have success at Club Level and in 2008 began entering national competitions . He moved to Chorley PS in 2012 and helped them to come 2nd in the FIAP World cup in 2014 and reach the finals of both the PAGB inter-club championships. His achievements include winning a FIAP Blue Badge as the best photographer in the Finland Circuit in 2010. He followed this by gaining Blue Badges at the Northern Counties International and The Welsh International in recent years. He has also won a selection of medals in the BPE circuits, PSA Exhibitions and achieved his FBPE in 2014.

Adrian's style of photography is still developing in strange directions, with many of his most successful images being composites, with some of the elements being hand drawn. Not everybody's cup of tea, but he loves creating stories using photographs, to satisfy his own needs and imagination.
