

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1	This inter-club competition will be known as “ PIXELS ” and will take place annually. There will be no set theme. Entry will be at the invitation of Gwynfa Camera Club and entrants will be recognised photographic clubs, societies or similar organisations.
2	Each club/society shall enter four digital images, each being the work of a different photographer. Photographers must own the copyright of their entry and be able to assert their moral right to be associated with <u>all</u> aspects of the source elements of the entry. No photograph may be entered into to more than one ‘Pixels’ competition. Entries that are very similar to previous entries may not be used. Individual photographers may represent more than one club but only with different images.
3	There will be an entry fee of £10.00 (cheques to be payable to Gwynfa Camera Club).
4	Entry Size - Each digital photograph must conform to the following file specifications: a) <u>Maximum</u> Width: 1920 pixels b) <u>Maximum</u> Height: 1080 pixels c) <u>File Type:</u> JPEG only d) <u>Resolution:</u> Anything from 72ppi to 300ppi is acceptable. Note: As we will be projecting at 100%, lesser file sizes may appear smaller when projected. For example, 1024x768 will appear considerably smaller. 1400x1050 just a little smaller.
5	Submission of entries - there are two options. <u>Preferred method</u> :- Send your entries by e-mail to leigh@coform.com together with a scan of your completed entry form. Then send your entry fee by post within 5 days. If you don't have a scanner please include in your email the title of each photo, the names of each photographer and the preferred projection order. Email entries will be acknowledged when received. If you don't receive an acknowledgement, please check receipt. Entries can be delivered in person by prior arrangement - see below. <u>Alternative Method</u> : - Send your entries on a CDR together with your completed entry form and payment to the address shown on the entry form. (No CDRWs please).
6	A judge will be chosen from outside the Welsh Federation and will be asked to assess the entries using a properly calibrated computer monitor.
7	The ' Gwynfa Pixels Trophy ' will be presented to the club achieving the highest aggregate score. In the event of a tie, the winning club shall be determined by highest number of 20s, 19s, 18s etc. Awards will also be made for the entries deemed by the judge to be ' Best Monochrome ' and ' Best Colour ' photographs. Trophies do not need to be returned.
8	Gwynfa CC reserves the right to use 'Pixels' entries for publicity and/or for circulating as a portfolio presentation. Entries originating from WPF clubs may also be passed on to the WPF for use in inter-federation events. In such cases the photographer will be duly credited.
9	Submission of an entry implies acceptance of the above conditions.
