

MEMORIAL TROPHIES DAY 2018

PLEASE NOTE THE CHANGE OF DATE FOR THIS COMPETITION

A series of three competitions will held on **Sunday 21st January 2018**, comprising of the following:

The Walter Morgan Memorial Trophy.....for Monochrome Prints

The Gwyn Morgan Memorial Trophy.....for Projected Digital Images

The WPF Memorial Trophy.....for Colour Prints

The competitions collectively shall be known as the WPF Memorial Trophies Day.

The competitions will be held at **Shelone Road Community Centre, Shelone Rd, Briton Ferry, Neath SA11 2NS**

An admission fee of £10 will be charged for entry in to one or all the competitions. The Walter Morgan Trophy competition will start 10.00 am, and the Gwyn Morgan Trophy Competition will follow, starting not before 11.30am. The WPF Memorial Trophy will start at 2.00pm, following a lunch break. Hot and cold drinks will be provided throughout the day, but lunch will not, so you are advised to bring your own.

The judge will be Rod Wheelans FRPS, MPAGB, APAGB, MFIAP, Past President of the PAGB, and a judge with an outstanding record of judging up to and including International Competitions .

Prints must be delivered to the WPF CELO by Friday 22nd December, together with entry form and entry fee. In the case of the WPF Memorial Trophy (the Competition for colour prints) each print to be accompanied by a PDI of the image.

Multiple Club Membership

The Memorial Trophies Day Competitions comprise 3 **separate competitions**. A member can enter an image in one or more Competitions, if selected to do so. If a person has membership of more than one Club that person will be allowed to represent one Club in one competition and a different club in the other competitions. Competition secretaries are advised to check that this rule is adhered to by those whose work is submitted for the Competitions.

THE WALTER MORGAN MEMORIAL TROPHY

Entry

- An entry must consist of FOUR MONOCHROME prints.
 - Entries to be submitted by affiliated Clubs of the WPF
 - No more than one print per author
 - The copyright of the whole image must be held by the entrant.
 - No print must be entered which has previously been entered for this competition, or accepted in any Welsh Salon of Photography. All entries will be eligible for entry into the 2018 Salon.

Prints to be delivered to the WPF CELO by Friday 22nd December, together with entry form and entry fee.

Appraisal of entry

- Each club's submission will be viewed as a set of 4 prints
- Sets will be assessed by elimination; the highest-ranking set will be deemed to be the winner and entitled to receive the Walter Morgan Memorial Trophy

Winning and runner up sets of images will be displayed on the WPF Website, and certificates will be prepared and sent to the Clubs

Judge will be asked to select a Best Picture and Best Portrait image from the entry.

THE GWYN MORGAN MEMORIAL TROPHY

Entry

- An entry must consist of FOUR projected digital images with an Open subject.
- Entries will be submitted by affiliated Clubs of the WPF
- No more than one image per author
Images must be maximum width 1400 pixels and maximum height 1050 pixels
- Entries may comprise monochrome or colour digital images in any proportion.
- The entrant MUST hold the copyright of the whole image.
- Images must not have been accepted in any previous Welsh Salon of Photography, but will be eligible for entry in to the 2018 Salon

Images to be delivered to the WPF CELO by Friday 22nd December, together with entry form and entry fee.

They can be submitted on disc or memory stick, or emailed to martinnagle1@hotmail.com

Appraisal of entry

- Images will be projected to an audience, and scored with a mark of up to 20 points
- The judge will announce each individual score as it is appraised.
- Each Club will have an image displayed in turn
- The club submitting the 4 projected images having the highest total shall be the winner.
- The winning club will be awarded the Gwyn Morgan Memorial Trophy, which they will hold for a year.
- In the event of a tie, the winning clubs shall jointly receive the Trophy: the period of retention being mutually agreed between them.

Winning and runner up sets of images will be displayed on the WPF Website

THE WPF MEMORIAL TROPHY.

Entry

- An entry shall consist of FOUR colour prints. Each print to be accompanied by a PDI of the image.
- Entries will be submitted by affiliated Clubs of the WPF
- No more than One print per author
- The copyright of the whole image MUST be held by the entrant.
- Prints must not have been accepted in any previous Welsh Salon of Photography, but will be eligible for entry in to the 2018 Salon

Appraisal of entry

- Images will be displayed to an audience, and scored with a mark of up to 20 points
- The judge will announce each individual score as it is appraised.
- Each Club will have an image displayed in turn
- The club submitting the 4 prints having the highest total shall be the winner.
- The winning club will be awarded the WPF Memorial Trophy which they will hold for a year.
- Judge will be asked to select a Best Picture and Best Portrait image from the entry.
- In the event of a tie, the winning clubs shall jointly receive the Trophy: the period of retention being mutually agreed between them.
